## **COUNTRIES AND NATIONALITIES**




- Usually, nationalities take similiar suffixes. For example:
  - -ish (as in England / Engl-ish, or Ireland / Ir-ish)
  - -ian (as in Canada / Canad-ian, or Brazil / Brazil-ian)
  - -ese (as in China / Chin-ese, or Japan / Japan-ese)

## YES/NO QUESTIONS

- If a question should be answered with "Yes, \_\_\_\_\_" or "No, \_\_\_\_\_" we follow the same rule.
- 1- After saying Yes or No, we:
- 2- Look at the targeted person.

  (Ex: in the question: "Will your parents come to the meeting?", subject is "your parents". So, it becomes "they" in the answer.)
- 3- Look at the auxillary verb of the question. It is usually the first word. (Ex: in the question: "Will your parents come to the meeting?", the word is "Will". So, we write "Will" in the answer.)
